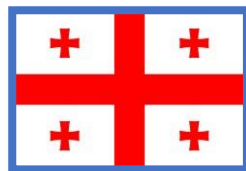

## VENUE

The Tournament shall be held at the Tal-Qroqq Sports Complex in Gzira, in an open-air 50meter pool with an adjacent 25 X 25-meter diving pool. This diving pool will be used for warmup and cool down during the competition. The venue is equipped with Omega electronic timing equipment, a scoreboard displaying running time of the match, exclusion time and score as well as names of teams and players. Four 30-second shot timers are also available.



The Tal-Qroqq Sports Complex abides by International Olympic Swimming Standards and follows safety procedures on security, first aid and fire-fighting and also provides medical care on call.

Other facilities available at the complex are changing rooms and showers, meeting rooms, an Arena sports shop and a cafeteria. The spectator capacity is 3000 pax.

## COMPETITION REGULATIONS

The Tournament will be run in accordance with the LEN General Event Rules and the Event Regulations governing the European Junior Water Polo Championships.

## SANITARY REQUIREMENTS FOR COVID-19

The Championships will be held under the “bubble” concept and the LEN Sanitary Protocol as well as any other local laws and regulations must be abided by at all times.

Teams from the red zone will be allowed to travel to Malta for this event provided that all involved ensure the “bubble” concept is respected at all times, and follow the airport-hotelsport venue-hotel-airport flow without going out and mixing with others, not even mixing between the different teams.

Furthermore, teams from the dark red zone will be exempt from quarantine as long as the epidemiological situation does not worsen, and provided that they strictly adhere to the protocols and criteria outlined in the Sanitary Protocol.

It would of course be preferable if all participants are fully vaccinated by the time they arrive in Malta.

All nations are requested to submit a named list of all the members of their contingent. The list must include name and surname, passport number and expiry date, mobile telephone number and designation. These lists will be submitted to the Public Health Authorities for their approval to be provided on a named basis. The approval will be sent to each Federation and each Head of Delegation must have a printed copy when travelling to Malta.

Upon reaching Malta, each delegation must provide a negative PCR COVID-19 test, carried out not more than 72 hours prior to their arrival in Malta. Persons who fail to produce this test may be submitted to testing in Malta, at their own cost, and may also be subjected to a quarantine period.
